



Privacy policy and GDPR of the portal GREEN PROJECT EXPO

§1. General information

1. The administrator of your data is Greennovention LLC based in Łódź at 32/34 Żeligowskiego St. entered into the Register of Entrepreneurs under the KRS number: 0000452899, with the following number of the National Official Register of National Economy Entities (REGON): 146560390. All registration files of our company are kept by the District Court in Łódź.
2. Data protection is carried out in accordance with the requirements and generally applicable law, and their storage takes place on secured and specially delegated servers.
3. The term "GDPR" used later on in this document means Regulation 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the EU Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing of Directive 95/46 / EC.
4. For the sake of security of the data left on our portal, we have implemented the Secure Socket Layer (SSL).

§2. Data administration

1. The portal manager is the administrator of your data. This means that if you have an account on our portal, all data such as: name, surname, e-mail address, project name, telephone number, the amount of the total project budget, IP address, etc. is processed by us.
2. This portal implements the formula of obtaining information about projects and their progress only through information forms filled in and sent by the user.

3. The data provided in the form is processed for the purpose resulting from the function of a specific form, eg in order to process the service of the information contact.
4. All data is processed on the basis of the consent granted by the User of the portal and in cases where the law authorizes the Administrator to process data in order to implement the contract concluded between the parties.
5. The data you provide on our portal will not be sold or made available to third parties, in accordance with the provisions of the Personal Data Protection Act.

In the interest of the security of the data entrusted to us, we have developed internal procedures and recommendations to prevent disclosure of data to unauthorized persons. On our part, we ensure that we control their performance and constantly check their compliance with the relevant legal acts - the Act on the protection of personal data, the Act on the provision of electronic services, etc.

6. Each person whose data is processed by us has the right to directly access, rectify or limit their processing.
7. Each user who creates or completes the design form on our portal has the right to modify its content and to stop processing information at any time.
8. In order to protect sensitive information (used in the process of logging into our platform - login and password), we have introduced a data encryption formula. This means that the administrator of our portal does not have the ability to learn or change your profile personal data used to create an account.
9. We reserve the right to process your data after the expiry of the applicable Agreement or the withdrawal of consent only in the scope of pursuing possible claims before a national court or in the event that international law obliges us to retain data.
10. The administrator of our portal also has the right to share your data with other authorized entities on the basis of relevant legal provisions (eg law enforcement authorities).

§3. Cookies

1. This website uses "Cookies" that are stored on the User's computer.

Our "Cookies" are used to:

1. Reading the information contained in the Google Analytics service (The cookie stores information anonymously and assigns a randomly generated number to recognize unique users.)
2. Authentication and safe registration / logging in to the website.
3. Allow payment on the website without storing any information about the patches on the server.
4. Securing the registration forms, eg the Newsletter.

§4. Purposes and basics of processing

The administrator of your data will process it for the purpose of:

1. Conclusion and implementation of the contract (provision of marketing services) - in accordance with Article 6, paragraph 1a of GDPR.
2. Investigating or defending any claims under Art. 6 sec. 1f of GDPR.
3. Conducting activities to protect the identity of your projects - in accordance with Article 6, paragraph 1b of GDPR.
4. Archiving data on concluded contracts, placed orders or filing complaints - in accordance with Article 6, paragraph 1c of GDPR.
5. Sending feedback to the submitted comments, requests, objections or complaints - in accordance with Article 6, paragraph 1f of GDPR.

§5. User rights

1. The user of our portal has the right to object to the processing of data described above at any time. Data processing will cease upon receipt of the objection, unless we are able to demonstrate that there are legitimate grounds for us in relation to your data, which may be used by us to establish, assert or defend claims.

2. The user of our portal has the right to withdraw consent at any time to conduct resulting marketing activities for the activities of our website.
3. The user of our portal may withdraw his consent to data processing at any time, without giving any reason. Withdrawal of consent for all processing purposes will cause the User's account to be deleted from the website, along with all user data previously processed by the administrator.
4. We kindly inform you that the processing of user data, until the consent is withdrawn, remains in accordance with generally applicable law.

§6. Data storage period

Your data made available via forms, concluded contracts or sent letters will be processed by:

1. The entire period for which the services will be provided.
2. The entire period of invoicing or posting.
3. The period for archiving electronic correspondence, but not longer than one year from the date of the last correspondence exchange.

§7. Data recipients

At any time your data may be transferred to the following:

1. Law firms that have initiated or are conducting proceedings on our behalf.
2. Entities related to the Administrator.
3. Authorized employees who contribute to the proper functioning of the portal.
4. Authorized state institutions and bodies.

Information on the disclosure of data and the consequences of non-disclosure

Sending personal or design data via forms is voluntary, but nevertheless necessary for the proper functioning of the portal. Failure to provide data or its incorrectness will limit the registration possibilities and the possibility of issuing invoices.

We reserve the right to change the privacy policy of our website, which may be affected by the development of internet technology, possible changes to the law in the field of personal data and the development of our website.
